809. Minutes

810. Co-option

811. Report from County Councillor Nick Clarke

County Councillor Clarke gave a report outlining drastic budget cuts for the coming financial year. He also confirmed that he had requested a Central Government Statement about the liability surrounding the supply of gritting bins. Several Parish Councillors asked questions including complaints about the poor level of gritting in the county.
