1707/01	<p><b>Public Forum:</b> Residents attended the meeting to hear what Council were going to say in regard to the removal of the no 18 Whippet Bus Service to Newmarket. Cllr Kelleway explained that council were in touch with Paul Nelson at Cambridgeshire County Council. Whippet has given six weeks' notice of the removal of the service and if it cannot be replaced the service will stop at the beginning of September. Paul Nelson is trying to find an alternative provider. People prefer to go to Newmarket on Market days. Residents have handed a letter to the bus driver Saying pensioners would be happy to pay £2 for the journey. It was suggested the parishioners write to CCllr John Williams and to the Cambridge News (formerly Cambridge Evening News). Cllr Martin thanked Cllr Amrani on the work she has already done on this matter.</p> <p>Safety outside the school was also raised. There are more and more cars parking on the grass verges and there have been a number of near misses involving children. It was resolved to investigate the possibility of bollards being installed.</p>	
1707/02	<p><b>Apologies</b> were received and accepted from Cllrs Amrani, Hills, Oxford and Van de Walle all for personal reasons.</p>	
1707/03	<p><b>Litter Picker Update.</b> To date there has been no application for the litter picker vacancy. The Councils existing litter pickers have been approached Mr Parcell might be interested. The Clerk will arrange a meeting with him to discuss further. Another alternative could be the Clerks son who has expressed interest although won't be sixteen until December.</p>	Clerk
1707/04	<p><b>To receive an update on the use of the recreation ground for Keep Fit.</b> There has been no further response so it is likely she has found somewhere to hold her classes.</p>	
1707/05	<p><b>To consider requests for Use of the Recreation Ground for Archery.</b> It was resolved to support this subject to seeing Health and Safety Information including risk assessments and insurance documents. A lengthy discussion followed concerning the price that should be charged for use of the recreation ground. It was decided £8/hr for the Archery Club as the group is non- commercial. It was resolved to recommend at the next full council meeting (September) the proposal of £8/hr for non- commercial groups and £10/hr for commercial groups. The Clerk will put together a policy for the use of the recreation ground to be considered by the policies committee.</p>	Clerk
1707/06	<p><b>To consider the request for Support from Cherry Hinton GP Surgery.</b> It was resolved that the council would write a letter to support a GP service in Cherry Hinton North with the capacity to support patients from Teversham parish.</p>	Clerk
1707/07	<p><b>Planning</b> S/2356/17/FL for 1 and 3, Pembroke Way, Teversham for Demolition of the dwellings at 1 and 3 Pembroke Way and the building of 3 x houses and 2 x flats in their place. It was resolved to object to this proposal on the following grounds: a number of the rooms don't meet the minimum space standards and there is no privacy in the gardens of plot numbers 4 and 5.</p> <p>As an addition to the above application Council could ask for spoil to be taken to the Borley Way Play Area to make a mound to reduce the sound from the skate park. Cllr Kelleway has sought advice on whether planning permission is required for this.</p>	Clerk
