1	Apologies - were received and accepted from Cllrs Bramley, Freeman and Van der Walle all for personal reasons.	
2	To elect a Chairman for the year. Cllr Kelleway proposed Cllr Fisher remain as chairman for ensuing year, this was seconded by Cllr Hills and agreed.	
3	The Minutes of the last meeting held on 18 th March 2019 were agreed to be a true record and signed.	
4	Skate Park – as far as Council knows no further noise monitoring has been carried out. Councillors have seen the park being used and there have been no noise complaints received by the Clerk. The Heras fencing has been removed. A couple of the top panels of the ramps are damaged MRL Construction were asked to repair them and the Clerk has contacted them regarding this. Cllr Kelleway has noticed some shrinkage of the soil under the first fence that was erected. It was agreed that he and Cllr Fisher will move sand dumped under the hedge to fill in these gaps. 5	Play Equipment Maintenance/Repairs. Greg the Handyman has quoted £65 for the repair to the step broken on the climber at Lady Jermy Way and the removal and disposal of the old broken litter bin at Sheppard Way pocket park. It was resolved to go ahead with these repairs. In addition, the inspections were reviewed and it was agreed that the Clerk will make a list of all the work that needs doing and ask the Handyman if he can give us a quote for any of the work, he is able to do. She will also liaise with Safeplay regarding wet pour, inspection of wooden poles and the greasing of the swing collars at Ferndale pocket park.	Clerk

The Clerk assured councillors that it an area both she and groundsman are considering for work this coming winter.
