Minutes of Community Care Committee Meeting held on Monday 18th November 2019 at 6.30pm

Present: Cllrs Freeman, Hills, Kelleway, **Martin**, Sarah Thomson (Age UK Service Manager), Donna Allsop (Teversham Warden) and the Clerk.

	<p>Welcome, Introductions The new warden Donna Allsop was welcomed and introduced to the committee members.</p>
14	<p>Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr Hunt for personal reason.</p>
15	<p>Minutes. The minutes of the Extra Ordinary meeting held on 20th August 2019 were agreed to be a true record of the meeting and were signed.</p>
16	<p>Scheme Manager's Report and review of finances. It was reported that other villages are looking at warden schemes and the Council were asked whether they would be happy to join with another village. The response was yes in principle as long as it didn't adversely affect the residents of Teversham.</p> <p>There was a brief discussion on how to try and increase numbers as this is affecting the carry forward of the scheme and the warden does have capacity to increase the numbers.</p> <p>It was suggested to put fliers in the library and approach the rehabilitation centre on the Fulbourn Hospital site.</p> <p>Cllr Martin asked whether people were being missed. The problem is Age UK can only promote and ask if people would like to be considered for the scheme.</p> <p>It was also suggested that the Parish Council might be able to help with printing costs of a new flier to be delivered with the Teversham News. This would include the increased scope of the scheme to help other younger members of the community. The Clerk will put this on the next agenda.</p>
17	<p>Warden's Report. There are currently 7 people, from 5 household on the scheme. The warden spends the morning in Teversham and the afternoons in Stapleford. She collects pensions, prescriptions and picks up shopping. The scheme has been advertised in surgeries, chemists and Tesco's but as has already been mentioned it would be good to get more residents using the scheme.</p> <p>The Clerk will also send details of the parish area to the warden.</p>
18	<p>Signing of new agreement between Teversham Parish Council and Age UK Cambridge and Peterborough. The new agreement was approved and signed by Cllr Martin as the Committee Chairperson.</p>
19	<p>Lifelines. The Clerk reported that the Council are now only supporting one lifeline. An outline of the Lifeline support was given to the new warden.</p>
20	<p>Item to Report including Correspondence and Consultations. There was nothing to report.</p>
21	<p>Defibrillator. The Clerk updated the committee that the final installation of the defibrillator will be organised once the guardians are trained and ready to take on the regular checks.</p>
